

TBA:20 MOBILE PROJECTION UNIT AGAINST THE CURRANT ACCESS INFORMATION

Location 1: MARQUAM

Eastbank Esplanade under Marquam Bridge

- This location is accessible by foot, bike, wheelchair or car with no stairs or ramps.
- Closest address for Google Maps: 1945 SE Water Avenue
- The projection will be visible on the base of the bridge and can be seen from the parking lot to the North of the OMSI building.
- You may be able to see the projection from your car on Water St.
- The parking lot may or may not be open.

Location 2: MORRISON

Eastbank Esplanade Under Morrison Bridge

- Accessible by foot, bike or wheelchair
From 5 SE Madison (Firehouse at the East end of Hawthorne Bridge)
Go North .3 miles on the Esplanade to the Morrison Bridge. (no stairs or ramps)

OR

- From SE Yamhill and SE Water (near Lippmans/Hair of the Dog Brewery)
Go West up the ramp for the Morrison Bridge
Turn Left to go down the spiral ramp to the location under the bridge
(spiral ramp may not be the best option for wheels)
(Erin will walk and record distance and update here)

OR

- From the Westside SE 3rd and Morrison
Go West over the Morrison Bridge
Turn right on to the pedestrian ramp to the location under the bridge
(spiral ramp may not be the best option for wheels)
(Erin will walk and record distance and update here)

Location 3: BURNSIDE

Eastbank Esplanade Under Burnside Bridge on the floating walkway

- Accessible by foot, bike or wheelchair
From 5 SE Madison (Firehouse at the East end of Hawthorne Bridge)
Go North .7 miles on the Esplanade to the location under the Burnside Bridge

OR

- From 5 NE Oregon (near MODA Center)
Go South on the Esplanade .4 miles

OR

THIS ROUTE HAS STAIRS NOT ACCESSIBLE BY BIKE/WHEELCHAIR

- From SE 4th and Grand (Near Subaru Dealership)
Go West over the Burnside Bridge
Turn left down the stairs leading to the Esplanade

BY BOAT

If you have access to a boat and can safely navigate it in the dark, the project can be viewed best from the Burnside location.

BY CAR

If you have access to a car and wish to view the project without leaving your car, the project can be best viewed at the MARQUAM location

SAFETY/SELF-CARE and COMMUNITY CARE

- Please dress comfortably according to the weather conditions.
- The show will go on rain or shine!
- Please come prepared to walk in the dark, bring a flashlight and wear light colors for visibility.
- Please be mindful of pedestrians and bikers on the path and if you are moving slowly, stay to the right to allow others to pass on the left. Watch out for fast bikers!
- Please wear a mask and maintain at least 6 ft distance from others.
- **THERE ARE NO RESTROOM FACILITIES AVAILABLE.**
- The Hawthorne starting point is near a camp for unhoused people run by the city and JOIN. Please be respectful of the people sheltering and living in the neighborhood.

If you come across someone who may need assistance, please feel free to ask a PICA staff member. PICA staff will be distributing direct mutual aid in the form of food, water and supplies to anyone in need over the course of the event. We also encourage cash donations to JOIN and other services and mutual aid funds.
